Approval of Journal Entry of Judgment Forms

Chair Evelyn Z. Wilson called the Kansas Sentencing Commission (KSSC) teleconference meeting to order on April 24, 2018 at 5:02 p.m.

Chair Wilson reported on the concern of the Office of Judicial Administration regarding confidential information included in the Presentence Investigation Report (PSI) being distributed to Community Corrections and reviewed the language in K.S.A. 21-6813(c).

Chair Wilson further advised members of the KSSC Journal Entries Forms Committee's recommendation to amend the Journal Entry of Judgment by adding to the Miscellaneous Provisions in Section VII.7., a box for the Court to check when authorizing Community Corrections access to the confidential information listed in K.S.A. 21-6813(c). It is anticipated during the 2019 Legislative Session, there will be proposed legislation providing a statutory fix for this issue. Vice Chair W. Lee Fowler moved to approve the Committee's recommendation and Ms. Chris Mechler seconded the motion. The motion carried.
