

Dear current and prospective SB 123 Treatment Agency Providers,

The Kansas Sentencing Commission is pleased to announce its new SB123 New Provider Certification Training. This training is required for all treatment agency providers who are not yet certified and for all those who currently hold a temporary certification certificate for SB 123. This training is **free of charge** and open to those Treatment Agency Providers who complete the application process to be eligible to receive SB 123 funds for treatment services.

Additional training dates will be released regularly.

Please Note:

- All those individuals who will be making decisions on behalf of an agency, providing clinical supervision or guidance, providing direct service, completing billing claims, or interacting with supervisory agencies on behalf of offenders are encouraged to attend this training.
- Each training date has a limited number of seats available; these will be filled on a first come, first served basis.
- The trainings will be conducted virtually on the ZOOM platform and will last approximately 4 hours.
- Please email Gwyn Harvey, SB123 Certification Specialist at Gwyn.S.Harvey@ks.gov, with your preferred training date selection. Gwyn will email a confirmation and a ZOOM invite back to you.
- Training date availability will be updated on the KSSC website; please check availability prior to date selection.
- Participants are required to attend the entire training to receive certification credit. The expectation during the training is that cameras remain on, and participants are prepared to ask questions and to respond to discussion appropriately.
- Certificates of completion will be provided, however please note that SB 123 Certification is no longer a clinical training and CEUs are not offered through KSSC as a part of this training.
- Certification is not complete until training has been attended **and** the Implementation Plan for the provider agency has been approved. Certification status and effective date will be provided in writing to the Treatment Agency Provider Primary Contacts by the KSSC.
